(4) Creation House

This is related to Christian Life magazine, and has published many books with a neo-Pentecostal emphasis.

1. It developed its own schools.

(1) Oral Roberts University

- (a) Location - Tulsa, Oklahoma
- (b) Founder - Oral Roberts  
He was the famous healer-evangelist whose roots were in classical Pentecostalism although he is now an ordained Methodist clergyman.

(2) Melodyland School of Theology

- (a) Location - Anaheim, California
- (b) Founder - Rev. Ralph Wilkerson
- (c) Division

In November, 1978 ten faculty and staff members terminated their contracts and left Melodyland School of Theology over an administrative dispute. They went to Newport Beach, California which is only fifteen miles south of Anaheim and started a new seminary. This new seminary was called the Center for Theological Studies. It only had twelve students when it began and met in a local Christian high school. Daniel A. Tappeiner, who once taught *Systematic Theology* at Fuller Theological Seminary, was the dean of the faculty. After this division took place, Melodyland
