

- f. Became vice-president of the Watchtower Bible & Tract Society of Pa. (1940)
- g. Became President of the Jehovah's Witnesses (January 13, 1942)
- h. Emphasized the training of workers

Proof:

- (1) He established the Gilead Watchtower Bible School in South Lansing, N.Y. near Ithaca (1943)

This school was moved to 107 Columbia Heights in Brooklyn, N.Y. in 1969 - across the street from Bethel Headquarters. The facilities formerly used by this school are now being used for a "Kingdom Ministry School" which provides short training periods for workers who cannot attend the regular ten-month course of the Gilead School.

- (2) He organized "theocratic ministry schools" in every Jehovah's Witness congregation. Textbooks were published for use in these schools.
- (3) He published a new series of doctrinal books which are considered as authoritative doctrinal guides by the Jehovah's Witnesses
 - (a) The Truth Shall Make You Free (1943)
 - (b) Let God Be True (1946) Revised (1952)
 - (c) Make Sure of All Things (1953) Revised (1957)
 - (d) From Paradise Lost to Paradise Regained (1958)
 - (e) The Truth that leads to Eternal Life (1968)

Note: These books were issued anonymously, although it is believed that Mr. Knorr was their primary author.
