 - 2. Moved near Palmyra, N.Y. 1317 11 yrs. old
 - 3. Had vision in Spring 1820 -14 yrs. old
 - 4. Sept. 21, 1823 2nd vision
 - 5. Sept. 22, 1327 -given Golden plates by Moroni
 - Worked on translation of plates in father-in-law's house in Harmony, Pa.
 - 7. Martin Harris has copy of part of translation of Golden plates checked
 - 8. April, 1829 Oliver Cowdery joins Smith
 - Testimony of three witnesses in front of every copy of Book of Mormon
 - 10. March 26, 1330 -Book of Mormon placed on sale in Palmyra Bookstore
 - 11. April 6, 1830 Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints officially organized in Fayette, N.Y.
 - 12. Some Mormons go to Kirtland, Ohio
 - 13. Some Mormons go to Independance, Mo.

 - 15. 1839 -Mormons go to Nauvoo, Ill.
