What you and I need to do is to make sure we understand these passages so that when people come and they approach us with these passages we can show them that they do not contradict the biblical teaching about the deity of Christ, but they are in perfect harmony with it. And then, having taken these passages away from them, then come back with those positive passages that we dealt with on Wednesday and show them that Jesus is God.

Be sure, folks, that you do this. You see, you can talk to somebody, and you can win an argument but lose a soul. I would encourage you, whenever you talk to somebody, to make sure that the plan of salvation is presented very clearly and very plainly. Just point out that Jesus is fully God and fully Man in one Person, and in that human nature He died to bear the equivalent of what the sinner would suffer in hell so that, if the sinner will repent of his sin and put his whole faith—his whole trust—in what Jesus did on Calvary's cross alone for his sin, then he can be saved from eternal punishment in hell and enjoy eternal life instead.
