b. Agreement

The predicate adjective agrees with the word with which it goes in gender and number, but it does not usually agree in definiteness (e.g.  $\neg \lor \lor \lor \neg \neg$  - "the man is good").

c. State

The predicate adjective is always in the absolute state (e.g.  $\Pi \subseteq \mathcal{O}$  ,  $\mathcal{O} \subseteq \mathcal{O}$  ).

- C. Substantive Adjective
  - 1. Definition of the Substantive Adjective

The substantive adjective is the adjective used like a noun (e.g.  $\square 107$  - "the good one" or "the good thing").

2. State of the Substantive Adjective
