- II. The Psalms.
 - A. Biblical material concerning David.
 - 1. Material in the books of Samuel and Chronicles.
 - -There are <u>58</u> chapters in these books concerning David:
 - a. 11 Sam. 16-30.
 - b. 2 Sam. 1-24.
 - o. f' Chron. 11-29.
 - 2. Material in the book of Psalms.
 - -75 Psalms (1/2 of the 150) are ascribed to David:
 - a. The Psalm <u>titles</u> ascribe <u>73</u> Psalms to David:

Psa. 3-9, 11-32, 34-41, 51-65, 68-70, 86, 101, 103, 108-110, 122, 124, 131, 133, 138-145.

- b. The New Testament ascribes 2 Psalms to David which are not ascribed to him by the Psalm titles.
 - 1) Psa. 2 in Acts 4:25.
 - 2) Psa. 95 in Heb. 4:7.
 - -Psalms 2 and 95 are among the 34 orphan Psalms (ones which have no title on them).
- B. The establishment of Psalmody in Israel.
 - Psalmody is the singing of Psalms in the worship of God.
 - David appointed 10 Levites and 2 priests to sing psalms with instrumental accompaniment daily in front of the tent in which the ark of the Lord had been placed in Jerusalem.
 - BACKGROUND!
 - -1 Chron. 13: David attempts to move the ark from Kiriath-jearim to Jerusalem. Uzzah is killed in the process (cf. Num 4:15). Ark is placed in the house of Obed-edom.
 - -1 Chron. 15: David moves the ark (correctly this time, v.11-15) from the house of Obed-edom to Jerusalem.
