

as His humanity is concerned, but no one from the tribe of Judah could be a priest, for a priest had to descend from the tribe of Levi and the family of Aaron. If David's Lord then were to be a priest after the order of Aaron. He couldn't be both a king and a priest at the same time. That is why David predicted He will be a priest after the order of Melchizedek.

e. Purpose of the priesthood

The purpose of the priesthood is to do what is necessary to enable man to enter directly into the presence of God and to have fellowship with Him cf. Heb. 7:11-19

6. Conquest of the enemies of David's Lord vss. 5-7

a. Description of the conquest vss. 5,6

David predicted that the LORD (Jehovah) will fight for David's Lord and will do the following:

- (1) He will manifest His anger against all the kings who are enemies of David's Lord and kill them vs. 5. This will be fulfilled at the second coming of Christ when by His word Jesus will kill all the kings of the earth that will be gathered together against Him and His army cf. Rev. 19:19-21.
- (2) He will bring judgment upon all the nations that are enemies of David's Lord and as a result fill the place where they will be gathered together with dead bodies vs. 5a. This will be fulfilled at the second coming of Christ when by His word Jesus will destroy all the armies of the nations (cf. Rev. 19:15a) that will be gathered together against Him and His army, and as a result, fill the place where these armies will be gathered together with dead bodies cf. Rev. 19:19-21. According to Rev. 19:21 the fowl of the air will eat the flesh of these dead bodies.
- (3) He will kill all the rulers of the earth who are enemies of David's Lord vs. 5b. This will be fulfilled at the second coming of Christ when by His word Jesus will kill all the "mighty men" that will be gathered together against Him and His army cf. Rev. 19:18 - "mighty men" and vss. 19-21.

Note: In Psa. 110:5,6 David predicted that the LORD (Jehovah) will fight for his Lord and he indicated what the LORD
